

Policy for potential covid exposure at an event/meeting

1. The Seneschal must gather the following information from the individual(s) who advise they have tested positive: a. When were they exposed? b. When were they symptomatic? c. When was the event?
2. Gather the contact tracing information for the people who attended that meeting/event. This is either the required sign-in sheet or pre-registration form required for weekend events.
3. Inform the Kingdom Seneschal of the exposure event and include the details gathered above
4. Per corporate guidance you may not share with the local health department the exposure of individuals at the event. However, the infected person may choose to do so, and may provide the contact information of the local seneschal.
6. For a kingdom level (weekend) event the Kingdom Seneschal will post the information of a potential exposure on the Middle Kingdom's Facebook Page, as exemplified below, with the commenting turned off and on the Kingdom Website. Remember, compassion is warranted, not vitriol.
7. For a local level event (fight practice/meeting/other gathering) the Local Seneschal will post the information of a potential exposure on the local groups Facebook Page or other electronic communication, as exemplified below, with the commenting turned off and on the Local Website. Remember, compassion is warranted, not vitriol.
8. Sample post may be something along the lines of:

This afternoon it was reported that an individual who attended __EVENT__ on _DATE(s)_ tested positive for COVID-19. This announcement is to inform those who attended and the Kingdom/Barony/Canton/Shire/College as a whole. We encourage those who were at _EVENT_ to follow CDC guidelines, and if applicable, self-isolate. If able, we also encourage testing for COVID-19. If we are contacted by the local Health Department upon request will provide a list of attendees using the information gathered from the Contact Tracing Sign-Ups.

Because our practices & gatherings have been diligent about sign-ups at events, we are able to gather this contact information quickly and act accordingly. If you attended _EVENT_ and test positive within 7 days, and have not already notified the local Seneschal, please contact the Kingdom Seneschal to advise. Remember that no one is required to attend events and we encourage you to do what makes you feel comfortable. 9. If contacted by a local health department and asked for the contact tracing list please provide it. If you are requested to contact persons on the list and inform them please use the wording above. In either case please contact the kingdom seneschal.

Attendance by those who have tested positive for Covid prior to Events

If you receive notification that an individual has tested positive, please following the procedures.

Remind your local populace to follow CDC guidelines following positive tests.

- For most adults with COVID-19 illness, isolation and precautions can be discontinued 10 days after symptom onset* and after resolution of fever for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medications, and with improvement of other symptoms.
- For adults who never develop symptoms, isolation and other precautions can be discontinued 10 days after the date of their first positive RT-PCR test result for SARS-CoV-2 RNA. 2.

An example of how this works: Sir Viral tested positive on September 7, 2021. Sir Viral cannot attend a meeting or event on or before September 17, 2021. Sir Viral is permitted to attend the event on September 18, 2021. 3.

The Seneschal/Event Steward should refuse admittance to those with known positive cases in order to not expose the others in attendance. The Seneschal/Event Steward MUST have proof of the positive test, such as a screen shot that the individual announced they tested positive, and email sent by the individual advising they tested positive, etc. Verbal notifications require witnesses so it can't become one word against another. If the individual is asked to leave and they don't, Seneschal/Event Steward can call local authorities. In either case, an incident report MUST be filed, which includes the proof of positive testing to the Kingdom Seneschal.
